### Talk on preventing suicide and self-harm

RTE Person of the Year award winner **Joan Freeman** will speak on this subject in St. **Gemma's Girls' High School**, Ardilea Street, Oldpark Road, on **Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> October from 7.30 to 9.00 p.m.** Joan gave up her private psychotherapy practice to research the causes of suicide and self-harm. She then opened Pieta House in Dublin in 2006, with six qualified therapists, to help people who are self-harming or suicidal. There are currently five Pieta centres in the Republic of Ireland. Joan has great experience with and understanding of the issues of suicide and self-harm and has many insights to give families coping with them. All are welcome to this evening.
