Libraries NI has announced that Falls Road Library will be holding three events in the autumn with local author Bobby Devlin, which adults are invited to come along to enjoy.

*The **Judges Daughter** event will take place **on Monday 17th October**, when Bobby will recall the events surrounding the Patricia Curran murder. Patricia Curran was the daughter of a leading judge. A young soldier was convicted of her killing, but cleared nearly 50 years later. The mystery has never been solved. This event will take place from **6.00pm – 7:00pm**.*

The final event in the series, **Relive the Falls Road during the 1950s**, will take place on **Monday 14th November, from 6.00pm - 7:00pm**. You are invited to come along and join Bobby for an evening of chat and humour, as he reminisces about the Falls Road during the Rock and Roll era.

Bobby Devlin was born and reared in Conway Street (Falls Rd) and went to Milford Street Primary School until he was 14, when he left to work in Andrew's Flour Mills. Bobby joined the R.A.F. as a teenager and did a five year engagement and after this, he was employed as a postman in Belfast's GPO. He was interned from 1972 - 1974. Bobby still lives in Belfast.
